International student research papers competition "Management, social and behavioral sciences in the implementation of the sustainable development principles"

According to the letter of the State Scientific "Institution Institute for Modernization of Educational Content" of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated 17.11.2021 № 22.1/10-2647 on the basis of Ivano-Frankivsk National Technical University of Oil and Gas (IFNTUNG) in 2021/2022 academic year will be to hold the International competition of student research papers "**Management, social and behavioral sciences in the implementation of the sustainable development principles**" by directions:

Social and behavioral sciences;

Management and administration.

The co-organizers of the Competition are Polissya National University and foreign educational institutions: Krakow Mining and Metallurgical Academy (Krakow, Poland), Gdansk University of Technology (Gdansk, Poland), Academy of Economics D. A. Tsenov "(Svishchev, Bulgaria), South-Eastern European University (Tetovo, Macedonia), Ariel University (Ariel, Israel), ISMA University of Applied Sciences (Riga, Latvia), Kosice Technical University (Kosice, Slovakia), Pomeranian Academy (Slupsk, Poland).

The purpose of the competition is to expand cooperation with foreign institutions of higher education, stimulate scientific activity of students, form a new worldview of future professionals, awareness of the need for change and transformation in the future to implement the principles of sustainable development at different levels of socio-economic systems.

The competition is held in two stages in accordance with the requirements for scientific work, which are defined in the "Regulations of the International competition of student research papers" Management, social and behavioral sciences in the implementation of the principles of sustainable development ":

The first stage (**until February 15, 2022**) is the preparation of scientific papers in higher education institutions and their submission to Ivano-Frankivsk National Technical University of Oil and Gas.

Stage II:

- review of competitive works (**until March 15, 2022**);

- - holding a final scientific-practical conference - by videoconference (**April 28-29, 2022**).

The competition is open to independently prepared by students scientific works (not more than two authors), which are priority, innovative or exploratory in nature within a certain area. Up to three scientific works in each direction from one institution of higher education can take part in the Competition. The abstract of the work and accompanying documents are submitted in national and English languages. Papers are submitted in the national / English language and must meet the requirements of the "Regulations on the International competition of student research papers" Management, social and behavioral sciences in the implementation of sustainable development principles". Competitive works must be registered in the appropriate section in a certain direction on the IFNTUOG website.

Invitations to the conference will be sent in **April 2022**.

All costs associated with participation in the International Scientific and Practical Conference shall be borne by the institution of higher education, which is represented by the winning applicant.
