REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS

The materials can be prepared in Ukrainian, Romanian or English. The manuscripts should be 2-4 full pages (including figures and tables). The page size is A4 format (297x210 mm). The pages should not be numbered. Times New Roman font 12 pt, single-spaced. The text should not be compressed. No hyphens are allowed. Indentation of paragraphs – 1.0. Page margins – 25 mm on all sides. The abstract should be sent through the **Google Form** as a single file with filename based on the last name of the first author (in Latin).

UDC index – left-justified alignment (12 pt)

The first name(s) and the last name(s) of the author(s), academic degree(s), affiliation, city, country – in the center (Times New Roman font, 12 pt., in italics)

TITLE OF THE ABSTRACT – in the center.

uppercase (Times New Roman 14 pt, bold).

Main text ... (after one blank line, with a paragraph in the main style, Times New Roman font, 12 pt., single-spaced, indentation of paragraphs – 1 cm, width alignment).

References – in the center

(after one blank line, Times New Roman font, 12 pt.)
