REQUIREMENTS FOR THESES REPORTS FORMATTING

➤ Theses reports must be prepared in **Microsoft Word** with margins (mm): top – 20, bottom – 20, left – 25, right – 10.

➤ **Font:** Times New Roman, **size 14, paragraph indent 1.25 cm, line spacing – 1, style – Normal**.

➤ On the first line (left) – section number; below – UDC. After one line (right aligned) – author information: surname, first name, patronymic (full), academic degree, academic title, institution name. Next, **in the center, bold** – the title of the theses report, followed by the text of the report.

➤ Tables should be concise and contain only necessary information. **Table title:** Times New Roman, 14 pt, bold, centered, spacing before and after – 6 pt.

➤ **Figure captions:** Times New Roman, 14 pt, bold, centered.

➤ **Font in tables and figures:** Times New Roman, 12 pt, single spacing.

➤ **References** should include only sources cited in the text. Citation example: [1, p. 127]; multiple sources [1, p. 128; 2, p. 55–56].

➤ The reference list should follow DSTU 8302:2015 «Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General provisions and rules».
